1. Can I still complete a FAFSA, even though I've been incarcerated or convicted?

Yes!

- Complete a FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid: <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>
- **21-22**: Summer 2022
- **22-23**: Fall 2022, Spring 2023, Summer 2023

You may still be eligible for federal grants and loans unless you were convicted of possession or sale of illegal drugs while you were receiving federal aid.





2. How do I complete the FAFSA if I did not file taxes or have income?

On your FAFSA you will mark that you did not file taxes and input any wages you did earn. If you did not earn income that year fill in all blanks with \$0. You may have to provide a non-tax filers letter from the IRS as verification to the financial aid office, but this does not prevent you from being eligible for financial aid.



3. What do I do if I need help filling out the FAFSA?

4. What if I'm interested in a Workforce Credential?

- Fast, affordable, credential, training courses
- Examples: CDL, HVAC, Electrical, Plumbing, Welding, Comp TIA A+ and so much more!







5. How do I pay for Workforce classes?

FastForward: Residents of Virginia

- ¹/₃ Student pays
- ¹/₃ Virginia Commonwealth pays upon completion of course
- ¹/₃ Virginia Commonwealth pays upon receipt of certification



6. What if I need help paying my $\frac{1}{3}$?

Student can complete a FANTIC Application and provide supporting documents

-VA Driver's License -Proof of Residency -Financial Verification: Taxes OR SNAP/TANF OR Bank statements -Selective Service Acknowledgement Letter -VA Career Wizard Assessment





7. What if I'm unable to currently provide financial information?

Get established at a bank, wait three months and apply after that time when you'll be able to provide 3 months worth of bank statements.

We have courses that start all the time! We want to help you succeed and will walk with you on the journey!







8. Am I still able to get credentials and licensing?

Yes, but sometimes there is a certain amount of time you have to wait to be licensed depending on the offense. Refer to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) for more information about your license.
